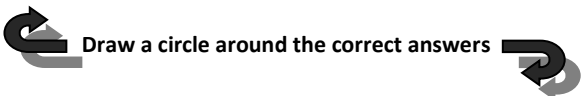
Here is a fun quiz sheet for you to complete as you make your way around the zoo.

**Malta    Madagascar    Majorca**



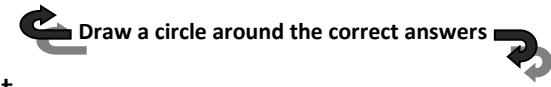
**4** How do Squirrel monkeys mark their territory? (It's a little bit yucky!)

**gang    troop    mob**

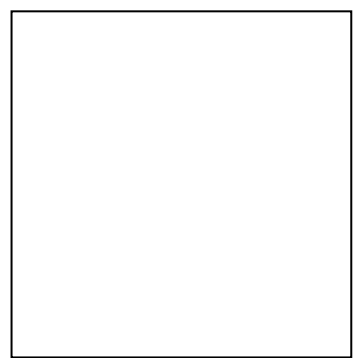
What colour is an emu's egg?    **red    white    green**

(Ostrich only have **2!**)

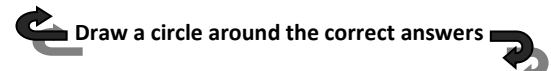
